Children grades 5 & 6, Cross Training is from 9:30-10:30 a.m. in the basement





"Without God, life has no purpose, and without purpose, life has no meaning.

Without meaning, life has no significance or hope. In the Bible, many different people expressed this hopelessness.

Isaiah complained: 'I have labored to no purpose; I have spent my strength in vain and for nothing.'

Job said, 'My life drags by – day after hopeless day' and 'I give up; I am tired of living. Leave me alone. My life makes no sense.'

The greatest tragedy is not death, but life without purpose."
