ANOTHER WAY RISEN SAVIOR IS GOING GREEN

Stewardship – we are responsible for all God has given to us, and we are to be good stewards of it. One way we are doing that at Risen Savior is by switching to a more cost-effective coffee (and vendor) that members rated as “better” than our current coffee. To also assist in this Green effort we are switching to non-Styrofoam products that are less harmful to us and our environment. These will be available for everyone who didn't bring a cup, including guests, visitors, and those who forgot their cup. Other ways to help is using recycling bins at church for all recyclable products, such as bulletins and using church silverware vs. plastic utensils for smaller events.
