1. Print Flat Jesus template below (page 2 of this document)
2. Child's first name in the box

4. Cut out Flat Jesus including name box
5. Take pictures of your Flat Jesus – work with children, depending on age level, to take very creative pictures of Flat Jesus (usually alone without other people in the picture) doing activities with toys, in your home, yard or neighborhood (several ideas online, but let your child think come up with something).
