Social Devotions:

Day 1: Do you need more peace? Scripture teaches us that joy and peace start with trusting God -- it is through our trust in Him that He fills us with joy and peace and allows us to overflow with hope! (Bible Verse: Romans 15:13 <https://www.bible.com/111/rom.15.13.niv>)

Day 2: God established peace for His people, the Israelites. He did this in their outward circumstances and within their hearts. He longs to do the same for you! Today, list out “all [you] have accomplished” and give thanks to God for His work. (Bible Verse: Isaiah 26:12 <https://www.bible.com/111/isa.26.12.niv>)

Day 3: God’s commands in Scripture don’t just teach us how to live -- they teach us that we can’t have peace without His instruction! He promises “great peace” to those who love His law. What can you do today to make more time for reading God’s Word? (Bible Verse: Psalm 119:165 <https://www.bible.com/111/psa.119.165.niv>)

Day 4: Would you describe your level of trust in God and His plan as “steadfast”? The Bible teaches that when we give our unwavering trust to God, we will experience peace. Is there an area of your life that you haven’t given to God? (Bible Verse: Isaiah 26:3 <https://www.bible.com/111/isa.26.3.niv>)

Day 5: God cares for you! He loves you deeply, and He knows everything about you. When you give your worries and disappointments to God in prayer, He will show you just how much He loves you. (Bible Verse: 1 Peter 5:7

Day 6: We are called to peace and gratitude. Does the “peace of Christ” rule in your heart? Is there someone you need to reach out to today to make peace? What have you thanked God for today? (Bible Verse: Colossians 3:15
