



## How Could This Be Possible?

In August, we continued developing written materials for the Hmong pastors to help teach the word of God. Fung did six days, 10 hours per day, online teaching with fifteen Hmong church leaders in Vietnam on the foundation of Christianity. This included topics like Law and Gospel, baptism, the Lord's Supper and worship. It was a fruitful teaching because two of the attendees received their baptisms at the end of the training. Aside from the blessed training sessions, we had the opportunities to minister to four families that suffered from persecution for their faith in Christ.

In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus says, *"Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven"* (Matthew 5:10). Everyone wants to go to heaven but no one wants to be persecuted. When persecution comes to those who put their trust in Christ, they don't feel blessed, but cursed. And yet, Jesus says, *"Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness"*. How could this be possible? Furthermore, in Romans, the Apostle Paul says, *"Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse"* (Romans 12:14). How could this be possible? Well, the Apostle Paul continues, *"We know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose"* (Romans 8:28). ## Baptisms
