

# Pastor's Messa

## Has this COVID-19 crisis decreased or increased your prayers to our Heavenly Father?

Some of you have matched the intensity of the moment with an increased intensity in your prayers. For others of you, you have been either so distracted by the chaos of a new work situation (or no work situation) and the disruption of family routines that your prayers have been moved to the back burner. The normal times and places for prayer, including Sunday



worship, aren't the same. Prayer hasn't found its niche in your new lifestyle.

Even if your time and intensity of prayer hasn't changed much, you might have noticed that the content and attitude of your prayer has shifted. Hopefully, your prayer topics have expanded and included more than your usual subjects - family, friends, work, church. Now you include health and safety. Now you include your concerns for the economy and people's livelihoods. Now you include prayers for the violence and destruction here in downtown Denver and other cities in our country. Now you include in your prayers answers to our country's racial tensions and political bickering.

It is good to let the Holy Spirit guide you in your prayers. Our prayer life is a conversation with God. It shouldn't be the same day after day. Your talk with God should reflect the changing landscape of our country and even the world.

Here are 7 things you could add to your prayer time that probably aren't on your list.

- 1) Safety from temptation Jesus instructs us to pray, "lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one" (Matthew 6:13).
- 2) Loving and understanding the Word
- 3) The spiritual needs of fellow Christians (not just their physical and financial needs)
- 4) Unity among believers.
- 5) God working through world leaders.
  Paul urges Timothy, "first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession, and thanksgiving be made for all people—for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness"

(1 Timothy 2:1-2).

- 6) Christians who face persecution
- 7) Christ's return to this world

Use this time wisely to deepen your prayer-life with your Heavenly Father through our Savior Jesus Christ.






**SHARP TOOLS** By now we've all heard the comment, "keep your tools sharp." BUT what does that really mean?



We will meet in the Fellowship Center so we will have plenty of room to social distance.





Otto and Grace served the Lord from baptism to grave in their earthly lives.

During the years when the children were growing up, finances were tight. But they were rich, because of the inheritance Jesus has laid in store for those who believe in Him.

"In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so I would have told. And If I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be where I am." (John 14)

When Otto was called home, Grace still had seven years to sojourn here. After a lifetime of meticulous money management, she was still worried. It had plagued her all her life. But God provided. She was cared for. She was comfortable. Yes, she even was content. True to God's provision, there was an abundance beyond her needs and

she passed that on to family as inheritance. Do you want help to craft a plan that will enable your family to celebrate that same inheritance?








