

How To Have Happy Holidays

The COVID-19 health crisis will have a huge impact on your Christmas this year. So how can you make this a Merry Christmas?

1. Celebrate the season, not just the day

We often put so much pressure on making Christmas Eve/Day THE celebration.

Obviously, you should do your best to make Christmas Eve/Day as special as possible but why not expand the celebration - before and after. Start the Christmas season off with a big Thanksgiving. Make Thanksgiving the best kickoff ever. Fun and festive food and drink should be given special attention. However, don't forget about the decorations, the music, and special games. Include a reading of Jesus' healing the 10 Lepers and how one came back to say thanks (Luke 17:11-19). Include an Advent Countdown Calendar to mark off each day to Christmas. Create special Christmas holiday music playlists to fill your life with joy. Use a December Christmas daily devotional book with your family. (Our family enjoys the Hallmark Christmas movies leading up to Christmas - always a happy ending!) Be creative.



2. Be generous, early and often

You have many opportunities to help people in need during the holidays. You get to choose which ones you want to donate to so others will have a blessed Christmas. Yes, you can give to one special charity, but consider helping as many as possible. Jesus said it this way: "It is more blessed to give than receive." Be creative.

3. Celebrate the 12 days of Christmas

This will be new for our family. We're like most people and once Christmas is over, it's over. But the old tradition of celebrating the Savior's birth all the way up to Epiphany, and the coming of the wise men is worth reengaging. It's not illegal to go Christmas caroling AFTER Christmas. Invite friends and family (if possible) for an After-Christmas party. Be creative as you give thanks for God's gift of a Savior at Christmas.


We have a drop off spot at Risen Savior for **donations of clothing, quilts, blankets and linens**. Check the Orphan Grain website for a complete list of needed items.
