

Arrested Again

In October, we continued doing outreach and online teaching with the Hmong in Southeast Asia. Fung taught three separated groups online with a total of 62 people for three weeks, ten hours per day. One evening, Fung prayed to the Lord saying, "Lord, I am exhausted from teaching. Please help me." The next day of the third class, someone reported about the training at the hotel to the local authority. Holding training without the local authority's permission is illegal in that country, but getting permission for any training is impossible. The local authority came and shut down the training. Some of the students had to go back and forth to the police station for questioning during the next three days. For Fung, he got to rest for three days without training anyone. It was hard to discern whether it was the Lord's will that the authority came to stop the training so Fung could rest; or was it the work of the devil? In Philippians 4, the word of the Lord says, "Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus" (Phil. 4:6-7). We knew that there was a risk for holding the training at the hotel without the authority's permission. But at the same time, we got permission from the Lord Christ Himself to hold fast to His word and not to fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul (Matthew 10:26-28).
