Coordinator of Church Services

Prepare and coordinate the elements of worship, assist the staff in clerical duties, and helping in other areas of ministry as needed.

Director of Administration

Provide overall management of the day to day operations of the Church facility and technology. Provide an on-site presence Mondays through Thursdays at the church.
