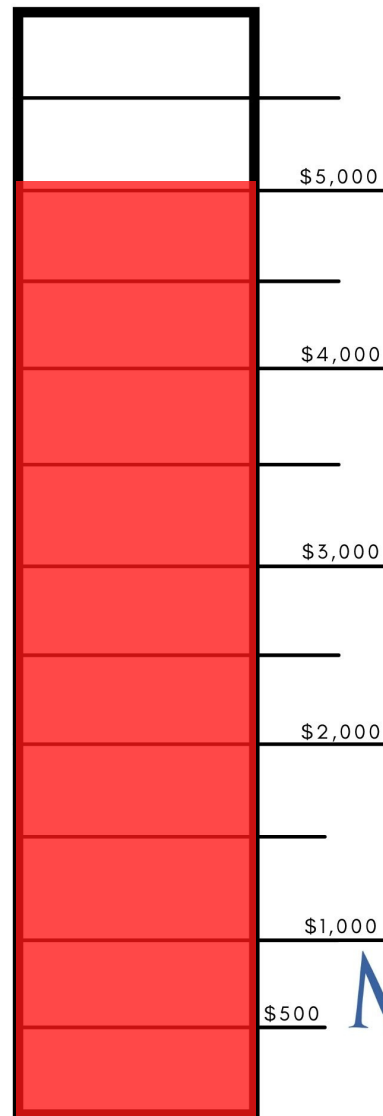
FUNERAL RECEPTION TEAM

Each bag contains a twin sheet set, blanket, pillow, small stuffed animal, wooden handmade toy, toothbrush, and toothpaste. Also, upon delivery each child receives a book that is personalized with their name. The faces of children light up when they are told that this bag is theirs to take home and keep.
