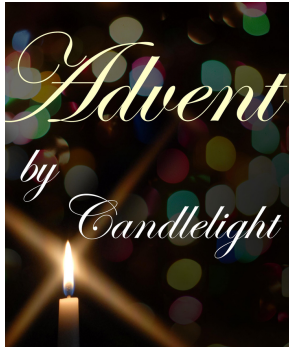


NEWS AND EVENTS

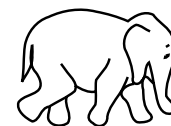
