NO CORNERSTONE IN NOVEMBER

Each year we have a Sunday of remembrance to celebrate All Saints Day.

One of our highlights this year is to remember those saints who have lived as members of Risen Savior and have gone on before us to be with the Lord. There are two bronze plaques that list their names in chronological order. (The plaques are in the alcove near the kitchen.) These saints have done much to support the ministry at Risen Savior from care of the church and serving as officers to leading bible studies. Their legacy is the foundation on which we are living saints who can enrich Risen Savior Lutheran Church.

In previous years we have purchased many mums and pansies to remember our own departed saints in our families. The plants were then taken home. This year we are purchasing a beautiful floral bouquet that will be left in place at church the entire month of November as a reminder of what our own legacy at Risen Savior might be. The new church year begins with the first Sunday of Advent. It should be a time of recommitting ourselves to the apostle's teaching, fellowship, breaking of bread and prayer. We rejoice and thank God for what the saints at Risen Savior have done and pray that our ministry will bring many more to be saints in Jesus Christ.
