OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

It's that time again! Grab a shoebox and fill it with items for a child around the world. Shoeboxes, labels and packing suggestions are available at the Operation Christmas Child display in the hallway.

There are 2 types of labels available: Adhesive labels allow you to donate the postage online and track your shoebox as it makes its journey around the world. Brochures include the label and an envelope that you can put your check donation in. When you return your shoebox, please attach the appropriate label, indicating the gender and age the box is appropriate for. Secure the box with a rubberband (NOT TAPE) and leave it at the OCC display by **Sunday, November 12**.

There are 2 options for postage donations:

- 1. Visit the website: samaritanspurseorg/occ and make your \$10 donation per box to cover postage. PRINT the shipping label for each box and return it with the shoebox to the display.
- 2. Make a check payable to Samaritan's purse for \$10 and place it in the envelope included with the brochure.
